



Inflation Instructions

WARNING READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE USE



The smaller bag contains 3 x gazebo sides and gazebo canopy.



The larger bag contains the gazebo frame, pump, 2 x fiberglass rods, screw in stakes for the guide ropes and side stakes.



4 x gazebo leg sandbag weights.

1.



Remove all the kit from the bags.

2.



Roll out the gazebo frame.

3.



Lay out the gazebo frame and extend all the legs out.

4.



Lay out the gazebo sides and awning. Confirm positioning and zip together. Each leg on the gazebo frame has a valve. Ensure all valves are closed. Open one valve and connect pump to inflate. Begin inflation.

5.



During the inflation process, when leg become firm push up from underneath. Ensure all the legs are lined up and the canopy is centered. Check the frame is firm.

6.



The canopy has two valves so close the one on the support tube. Connect pump to the other valve and inflate until awning is firm. (Do not over inflate.)



7. Position awning support tube into the Velcro located at the centre of the leg hub inside the gazebo. Insert the two fibreglass rods into position to tension the awning. These go on the inside of the awning into the white pockets. Be careful not to push too hard. Insert the side closest to the leg first and open the Velcro on the other side and secure.



8. Fix one sandbag weight to each gazebo leg. Attach leg strap to the bottom using the correct connector. Tighten the straps on the connectors once secured. The gazebo legs fit inside the centre hole of the sandbag weights. All 4 x sandbags weights must be used every time.



9. Green guide ropes should be used in moderate to strong wind conditions.



10. The screw in stakes should be positioned so that the green guide ropes do not cause a trip hazard. The ropes should be pulled taut to ensure the gazebo is secured.



11. Additional stakes have been supplied to secure the sides if they are blowing inwards.



- IMPORTANT NOTES:**
- Check the wind and weather conditions before commencing construction.
 - Check you have the full gazebo kit before you begin setting up and read the full instructions.
 - For safety reasons it is recommended that 2 persons set up the gazebo.
 - Ensure area of set up is free from any sharp objects and overhead objects.
 - In high winds or storms the gazebo should be deflated immediately, following the deflation instructions, and store it away.
 - Sandbag weights must be used every time with the gazebo.
 - Green guide ropes should be used in moderate to strong wind conditions.
 - Do not touch the over pressure valve system. These are the red valves inside the centre of the frame.
